Nature Conservation Ordinance 4 of 1975

section 90(2)

Hunting Regulations

Government Notice 60 of 1968

(GG 2881)

came into force on date of publication: 1 May 1968

The Hunting Regulations were originally made in terms of section 4 of the Nature Conservation Ordinance 31 of 1967, which was repealed by the Nature Conservation Ordinance 4 of 1975. Pursuant to section 90(2) of the Nature Conservation Ordinance 4 of 1975, the Hunting Regulations are deemed to have been made under that Act.

ARRANGEMENT OF REGULATIONS

[These regulations do not have headings.]

1. The period in which it will be lawful to hunt game, other than specially protected and, protected game, under licence and subject to the provisions of the aforementioned ordinance and these regulations shall be from the 1st June, 1968, to the 31st July, 1968.
2. The written permission of the owner of the land where a hunt is to take place, shall be produced before any hunting licence is issued to any person.
3. Birds of prey, classified as game, which do damage on farm yards, may be hunted freely in the period 1st May, 1968, to the 30th April, 1969.

These regulations shall take effect on, the 1st may; 1968.
