Allied Health Professions Act 7 of 2004

section 55 read with section 19(1)

Regulations relating to the Minimum Requirements of Study for Registration as a Dental Technician

Government Notice 18 of 2010

The Government Notice which publishes these regulations notes that they were made on the recommendation of the Allied Health Professions Council of Namibia.

Definitions

1. In these regulations, unless the context otherwise indicates, a word or expression defined in the Act has that meaning, and -

“the Act” means the Allied Health Professions Act, 2004 (Act No. 7 of 2004).

Minimum qualifications required for registration as a dental technician

2. (1) The minimum qualification, required by the Council for the registration of a person as a dental technician in terms of section 19(1) of the Act, is -

Regulations relating to the Minimum Requirements of Study for Registration as a Dental Technician

- (a) a National Diploma in Dental Technology, obtained at an educational institution after the successful completion of full-time study for a period of not less than three years at that educational institution; or
- (b) a Baccalaureus Degree in Dental Technology, obtained at an educational institution after the successful completion full-time study for a period of not less than four years at that educational institution,

subject to the other requirements prescribed by or under the Act.

(2) The curriculum of study for the National Diploma prescribed in subregulation (1)(a) must include the following subjects:

- (a) Dental Technology Theory I, II and III;
- (b) Applied Dental Technology I, II and III;
- (c) Dental Material Science I, II and III;
- (d) Oral Anatomy I; and
- (e) Tooth Morphology I.

(3) The curriculum of study for the Baccalaureus Degree prescribed by subregulation (1)(b) must include the subjects prescribed by subregulation (2), and must include the following subjects -

- (a) Dental Technology Theory IV; and
- (b) Dental Material Science IV.
