REGULATIONS MADE IN TERMS OF

Allied Health Professions Act 7 of 2004

section 55 read with section 41(1)(d)

Maximum Fine that Council or Professional Conduct Committee May Impose

Government Notice 60 of 2018

(GG 6564)

came into force on date of publication: 6 April 2018

The Government Notice which publishes these regulations notes that they were made on the recommendation of the Allied Health Professions Council of Namibia. It also repeals GN 20/2018 (GG 6527), which in turn repealed GN 158/2014 (GG 5559).

Note that GG 6527 was initially numbered incorrectly as GG 6528.

A corrected version was subsequently issued.

Definitions

1. In these regulations a word or expression to which a meaning has been assigned in the Act has that meaning and, unless the context indicates otherwise -

“the Act” means the Allied Health Professions Act, 2004 (Act No. 7 of 2004).

Maximum fine that may be imposed by Council or professional conduct committee

2. Under section 41(1)(d) of the Act, the Council or the professional conduct committee may impose a fine not exceeding the amount of N\$200,000.00 per charge.
